In 1974, Rabbi Menachem

Davidowitz and Rabbi Dovid Harris were sitting in a quaint house on Pinnacle Road with eight 9th grade students. They were starting small but their dreams of inspiring the next generation of proud and committed Jews were very big. It wasn't long before they created the Talmudical Institute of Upstate New York (TIUNY) with the collaboration and partnership of a few dedicated lay leaders, and instituted

an unprecedented academy of Talmudic scholarship and erudition in Rochester, New York.

Progress was steady and when the little house was outgrown, TIUNY relocated to the old Park Avenue Hospital building. Hundreds would pass through this nondescript structure, arriving as young boys and leaving as great men dedicated to enriching the lives of others.

Those humble beginnings created a colossal impact over the course of the next 48 years.


The Need









The Opportunity
